Behavior Intervention Support. It is a program developed to address negative behavior and create a positive atmosphere where student's positive behavior is rewarded.

Our school uses the Cardinal Coins whole class reward program to encourage positive behavior in Special Area classes as well as the in the cafeteria and on the bus. Each class will have the opportunity to receive a Cardinal Coin every day the class displays appropriate behavior during lunch and in their Special Area classes. Once each class receives 40 coins, the classroom receives a class reward.

Meal Applications = Funding for BRE

All students received free meals during the 2021-2022 school year due to a grant received by Sodexo. This year our district did not receive the grant and our students are expected to pay for breakfast and lunch. At this time, there is a \$1,367.49 balance on charged meals. If your child has charged meals, it is the expectation for the meals to be paid for. Letters are being sent home. weekly. If your child has charged meals and you have a balance due, you are allowed to set up a pay plan to assist with paying off your child's charges.

Here is where we can help you and you can help us. When a meal application is filled out and submitted, if the application is approved, our school receives funding based on the number of free/reduced meal applications completed each year. The funding is used to help purchase supplemental materials and other items to support our students' needs. You can help our school receive this funding by going to the Santa Rosa County Schools website: www.santarosa.k12.fl.us click on Free/ Reduced application. Follow the steps and within 48 hours your application will be processed.

Breakfast in the Cardinal Café

Students who arrive to school by car and want to eat breakfast in the cafeteria, need to arrive by 8:05, excluding our PreK students. Students who are car riders who arrive later than 8:05 have a difficult time getting to class before the tardy bell, 8:20. Every minute in the classroom makes a difference!
