

FSA Policies for Parents/Guardians and Students

Electronic Devices Policy—Any student in possession of electronic devices at any time during testing or during breaks will have his or her test invalidated.

Testing Rules Acknowledgment—All FSA tests include a statement that students sign verifying that they will abide by the testing rules.

Leaving Campus—If students leave campus before completing a test session (e.g., for lunch, an appointment, illness), they **will not** be allowed to return to that session.

Discussing Test Content after Testing—By signing the Testing Rules Acknowledgment, students also affirm that they will not discuss or reveal details about the test content (including test items, passages, and prompts) after the test. This includes any type of electronic communication, such as texting, emailing, or posting online, for example, on Facebook, Twitter, Snapchat, or Instagram.

While students may not share information about secure test content after testing, this policy is not intended to prevent students from discussing their testing experiences with their parents/families.

Working Independently—Students are responsible for doing their own work during the test and for protecting their answers from being seen by others. If students are caught cheating during testing, their tests will be invalidated. In addition, FDOE employs Caveon Test Security to analyze student test results to detect unusually similar answer patterns. Students' tests within a school that are found to have extremely similar answer patterns will be invalidated.
