# School News:

#### Face Coverings:

As part of SRCSB policies, face coverings are required while at school. Please remind your child to have their face coverings with them each day and wear them appropriately, covering their nose and mouth.

#### **Attendance**

Good school attendance is a major contributing factor to academic success in school. Our tardy bell is at 8:20. Students should be in their classrooms when the bell rings or they are considered tardy for school. All absences are unexcused unless proper written notification is received with 3 days upon the pupil's return to school. The school shall determine if the absence is excused or unexcused. Absences of 3 or more consecutive days may require a doctor's note to excuse. (Student Handbook)

Students who arrive to school by car and want to eat breakfast in the cafeteria, need to arrive by <u>8:00</u>. Students that are car riders who arrive later than 8:00 have a difficult time getting to class on time. Every minute in the classroom makes a difference!
